


M.P.S.M. Grace Convent, Mathura is a learning oriented organization where passion to learn and grow is clearly evident in one and all.


Our school is giving a child a platform where mutuality, interdependence, sharing, co-operation and a participative culture is brought to a common striving for excellence and for high quality delivers.

Our aim is to produce exceptionally well educated young people who go on to leadership positions in industry and government.






The learning model of the school is based on the use of latest technology in the classrooms and extensive use of visual learning, throughout the curriculum.

This technology has become an integral part of a teacher's life inside the class room in M.P.S.M. School, Mathura. The content available in the Smart Class consists of pedagogically sound and visually rich curriculum, providing 3 dimensional pictures, to enhance the creativity and imagination of the students.

Through e-learning students learn -

In M.P.S.M. Mathura efforts are made to ensure that all students starts conversing in English as early as possible. We recognize the socio-cultural background of our students and that is the reason why spoken English classes form a part of the Routine Time Table and the School Assembly.

M.P.S.M. Mathura has developed the English Language Lab to enhance proficiency in Spoken English through its emphasis on activity-based learning. The lab organizes a host of contests right through the year to promote confidence-building and personality development.

The English Language Lab trains students in Spoken English through a well-defined curriculum and focus on the skills of listening, reading, speaking and writing. The English Literary Club conduct sundry intra-school competitions through the year to help children polish their language skills.

English Language Lab programme is designed according to our school children, runs parallel to, and

Day Boarding Classes

(After Regular School Hours)

In M.P.S.M., Mathura Improvement Classes is used as a means to enable students improve in school work in preparation for Exams. Improvement classes involve additional instruction in core academic subjects, are usually given by children's regular teachers and normally take place after children's regular schools. They can therefore be seen as a private supplement to M.P.S.M.'s schooling, and are related to but distinct from the phenomenon of private tutoring that is common elsewhere in Mathura.

Those who are academically weak and willing to take day boarding classes in subjects like English, Maths

and Science throughout a year before SA I and SA II examinations are taking benefits of it. The period of time before examinations is to be used for as much revision as possible.

School has five and a half hours for most of its academic work. And then the kid is back home to either continue with assignment if given, or play video games or with friends or watch television. Often a weak student cannot understand the lesson because he has not understood the previous lessons in previous classes. Therefore such child should be taught individually after regular school hours in Day Boarding classes according to his understanding level and hence the need for Day Boarding classes to prepare them towards the examinations is designed by M.P.S.M., Mathura.





A Parent-Teacher Association is a formal organization composed of Parents, Teachers and Staff that is intended to facilitate parental participation in a school. Its role is to encourage closer links between home and school. At M.P.S.M. Mathura all parents and teachers are automatically members of the PTA.

The objectives of PTA is as follows-

Scholarship

M.P.S.M., Mathura awards Mahi Pal Singh Memorial Scholarship to the students those who are good in academics. This is an award of free Education for a student to further his or her education. Scholarship Award is based upon excellent performance in Scholarship Exam, which usually reflect the values and purposes of the Founder of the Mahi Pal Singh Memorial Social and Welfare Society. This Scholarship Award is for one session and every year Merit-based selection of students takes place.

Merit-based: This Award is based on a student's academic achievement and high scores on standardized tests. The Scholarship is awarded by the Mahi Pal Singh Memorial Social and Welfare Society.

There are three categories of Mahi Pal Singh Memorial Scholarship. From each category one student is selected for one session -

- Class 1st to IVth
- Class Vth to VIIth
- Class VIIIth to XIIth



SCHOOL MAGAZINE

Every effort has been made by, MPSM Mathura to make the School Magazine as accurate as possible every year before the commencement of new session. Quarterly Magazine Contains Class wise presentation of academic and co-curicular activities. The Quarterly Magazine has Academic Planner which provides dates for each term, School Events including Academic days, Weekly Test Days, Revision Test Paper Days, Holidays, Co-Curricular Activities days, Literary Club Activities days, Inter-House Competitions days, Sport events days, Parents-Teacher meetings and International World Days.

By following school Academic Calendar the Management help the parent and student body better co-ordinate.

DETAILED SYLLABUS

The teacher gives a student plenty of time to complete his/her work in class but it is found that slow writers are not able to note down their class work completely. Sometimes due to some unavoidable circumstances like illness, marriage ceremony at home etc. students would not be able to attend classes and miss class work data. All this can make a difference in the class performance of the students, as without having required data to learn subjects how could student perform good in studies.

Keeping all these things in mind, M.P.S.M. Mathura has been providing a Detailed Syllabus to the students and parents in hard copy as well as in PDF Format on School Website (www.mpsmgrace.in) to complete their class work on time without any hinderance. It has been found that it helps the students and parents a lot to be regular in studies and therefore students never miss a chance to become a topper of the class.





A healthy body and mind that can appreciate nuances of aesthetics in nature and diverse human activity is the sine qua non for becoming a balanced human being. Admission Procedure

The Admission Process is designed to enroll students demonstrating promise. A registration form is included with the prospectus. This is a co-educational institution. The policy of "First come first served" is followed in case of admission for both boys and girls. The School is open for students without any discrimination. Registration does not imply admission, but it is subject to the availability of seats and fulfilling of admission criteria. The registration fee is non-refundable.

Parents are required to submit completed hard copy of Registration Form with affixed recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate, father, mother on the Registration Form to school office within three days.

Parents are requested to go through the Prospectus carefully before filling the registration form. It is advised that parents should fill the Registration Form themselves to avoid any incomplete information, failing which the registration will be cancelled. The applications will be scrutinized and only those found complete in all respects will be selected for Admission Test. Intimation of the exact date and time will be given through SMS / telephone. Only those students who clear the written test will be considered for the admission and will be given Admission Form. The Principal reserves the right to assign any pupil the class for which she thinks the child is best suited. It is also subject to the availability of seats.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

- School leaving/transfer certificate and photocopy of the previous year's Report Card must be submitted within 15 days after the admission (without this no student from Class II onwards will be admitted).
- Recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate.
- If a pupil comes from an unrecognized school his/her admission can be had done, only after his/her transfer certificate is counter-signed by the School's Inspector.
- The transfer certificates (T.C.) of a pupil coming from a school outside Uttar Pradesh State must be countersigned by the education authorities of that district, in which the school is situated. Please send the transfer certificate in good time to the Principal of the formal school, for his counter-signature, as this is required to finalise admission.

Admission will be cancelled if any variance is found between the particulars filled in the Registration Form, Admission Form and the documents submitted for admission.

NOTE:

- The payment of fee is to be made through crossed cheque /demand draft at prescribed Bank only.
- The amount deposited towards registration and admission for a particular year is neither refundable nor transferable to any other year.
- Annual fee Revision may be as determined by the School's Board of Management.

Transportation

The school provides transportation facilities to students. The parents who want to send their children to school by school bus should apply for it at the beginning of the academic year. The school provides transport facility to the students through its own buses as well as chartered buses for transporting the students from different localities to the school and vice-versa.

Gentlemanly and exemplary behaviour is expected of all the students in the bus and at the boarding points where they wait for the bus. Strong and prompt disciplinary action will be taken against the students who misbehave.

If the school bus fails to ply on any day on account of some unforeseen difficulty, the students should come to school by other means. No complaint will be entertained on such issues.

We cover main trunk and feeder routes. Specific bus routes will depend on demand and will be determined at the beginning of each academic year. The school reserves the right to fix and/or change the bus routes as may be necessary from time to time. Parents will be duly informed about the bus routes before the classes commence.

Rules and Regulations

M.P.S.M. Mathura has set a clear set of standards for student behavior and expect our students to conform to the traditions of this school.

General Rules and Regulations:

- Students should treat school staff with respect all times and be courteous to fellow students.
- Students will refrain from damaging any form of school property. The school reserves the right to be compensated by the student for any such damages.
- Any form of bullying or ragging will result in a disciplinary committee review and could result in expulsion with a negative conduct certificate.
- Any misbehavior or violation of school discipline will be dealt with by the disciplinary committee and corrective action will be taken. In extreme cases parents will be called in to discuss the child's behavior and may lead to suspension or expulsion from the school.
- For safety and security, parents should refrain from sending money and valuables to school.
